Caring Communities Resource Centers provide mobile, one-stop access to health and social services in neighborhood communities with activities that promote aging in place and successful care giving. This includes:

assessments and care plans provided by a geriatric social worker,

• health screenings and education,

chronic disease self-management,

• mental health counseling in group and individual sessions,

• transportation, and

• support for caregivers.

RDI provides technical assistance in review and design of evaluation methods and surveys, conducts focus groups with key informants, creates databases, and analyzes data. Semi-annual evaluation reports encompass the outcomes and process evaluations.
